3.0 SECRETARYS REPORT

On a motion by Mrs. Reed seconded by Mr. Runk the Board voted to approve the Minutes from the Board of Directors Meeting held May 11th, 2017.

4.0 TREASURERS REPORT

The Treasurer Sallie Reed reviewed the financial reports for the period ending May 31st, 2017. On a motion by Mr. Connor seconded by Mr. Fragale the Board voted to approve the May 31st, 2017 financial reports.

- Discussion IDA Park mowing. Deering Landscape has agreed to complete our mowing again this year for the same price as 2016. On a motion by Mrs. Reed seconded by Mr. Antkowiak the Board of Directors agreed to accept the services of Deering Landscape for 2 mowing's at the IDA Park. The first mowing will be \$3,000 and a second mowing in September will be \$1,500.

 the Audit Committee will receive copies of the proposals and the Board of Directors will discuss the
 possible award at the July 2017 meeting.
- Discussion The Attorney presented a resolution "Quit Claim Bill of Sale" to transfer the sidetrack agreement from the IDA to PolyOne.
- Resolution On a motion by Mr. Fragale seconded by Mr. Connor the Board of Directors approved of the following resolution.

- WHEREAS, Transferor installed certain track facilities, consisting of an approximately 5,070 lineal foot sidetrack (the "Sidetrack"), at or near Lockport Station, County of Niagara, State of New York, pursuant to that certain Sidetrack Agreement between Transferor and Consolidated Rail Corporation, a Pennsylvania corporation, dated on or about July 1986 and that certain License Agreement between Transferor and General Motors Corporation, dated May 29, 1986, which track serves Transferee's Lockport facility, and
- WHEREAS, both said Sidetrack Agreement and License have been terminated by Transferor, and said Sidetrack is of no value to Transferor,
- WHEREAS, Transferee has requested that Transferor transfer all of Transferor's right, title, and interest in and to the Sidetrack to Transferee, and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Administrative Director be authorized and directed to execute a Quit Claim Bill of Sale for said Sidetrack.
